


Nuance PowerMic II DMO Job Aid

This job aid provides an overview of the Nuance PowerMic II functionality, use and how to customize buttons.

Functionality of Microphone

You can set up the microphone for various functionalities, toggling from one variable field to another, opening a diction box or transferring text.

Tip ► When using the Nuance microphone, be sure to press the talk to speak button while dictating.



Apply All Close Restore Defaults

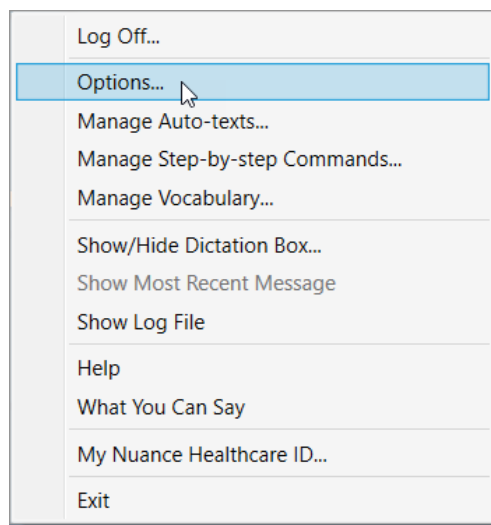
- When you press the  button, this will open a dictation box.
- When you compress the  button, this record your dictation. You must continue to hold down on the button during entire dictation.
- When you use the  or  buttons, this will allow you to toggle between the variables in the template/macro.
- When you press the  button, this will accept all default word(s) you have in a variable field.
- When you want to transfer your dictation into another application or field. Open the application and place your cursor in the text box and press the  button on your microphone.

Customizing Microphone Buttons

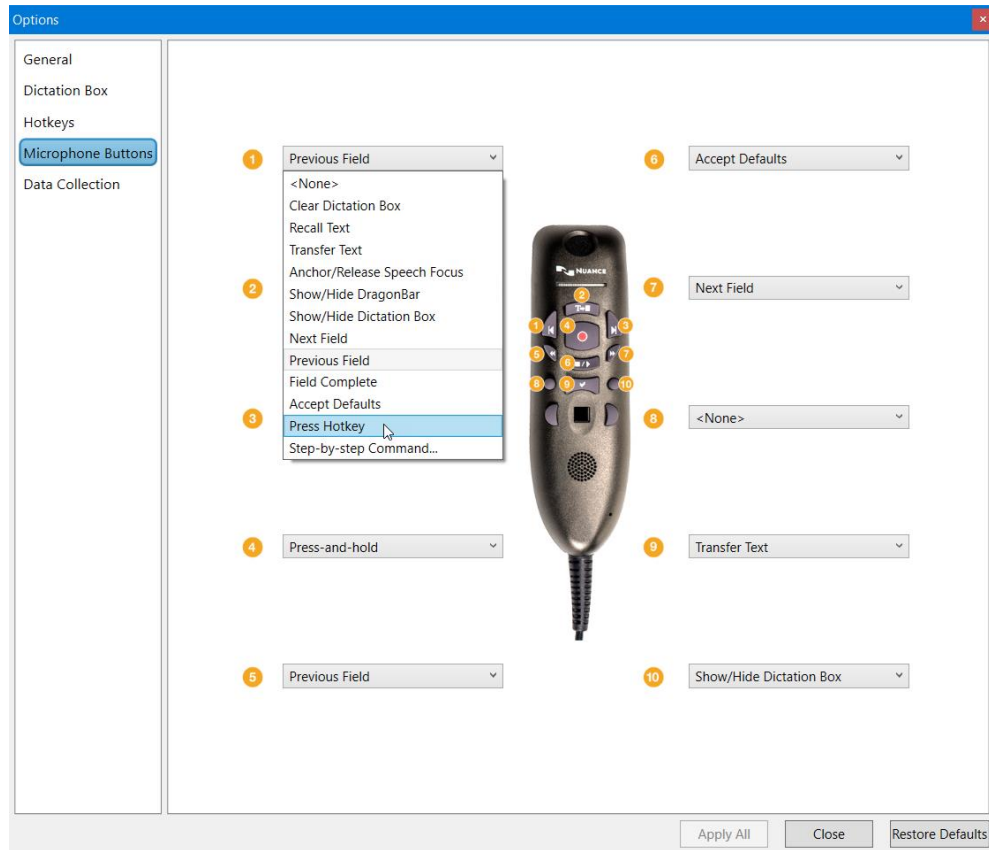
1. From the **Dragon Tool Bar** click on the blue Flame



2. Select **Options**



- Click on the drop down arrow of the button you would like to change.



- From the drop down, select the option you want for that button.
- Click **Apply All** then **Close**.
