## All elective rotations must be pre-approved by the rotation's preceptor, the Program Director, and Program Coordinator.

In addition to scheduled rotations, residents will be required to complete a continuity care experience. The consistency of clinic days and the schedule for individual residents' continuity care experience will be determined and scheduled by the Program Director and/or Program Coordinator. This experience will occur within a General Internist's office and residents will be expected to build a panel of patients to follow throughout their training. The emphasis on the panel's development should occur during the first two years of residency.
